TASAKI launches TASAKI Online Charity Project “MAGOKORO JAPAN 2018 for KUMAMOTO”

TASAKI (TASAKI & Co., Ltd.; Kobe Headquarter Office: 6-3-2 Minatojima Nakamachi, Chuo-ku, Kobe; Tokyo Headquarter office: 5-7-5 Ginza, Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Board Director & CEO: Toshikazu TAJIMA) will launch the TASAKI Online Charity Project “MAGOKORO JAPAN 2018 for KUMAMOTO” on Saturday April 14th, 2018.

TASAKI Charity Project “MAGOKORO JAPAN” was first initiated in 2011 to support the victims of the Great East Japan Earthquake. Under the project, TASAKI creates special jewellery every year with designs featuring multiple hearts nestled together to represent a deep love and bond, and donates all revenue to organizations that support earthquake victims. In 2016, TASAKI launched “MAGOKORO JAPAN for KUMAMOTO” to support those affected by the 2016 Kumamoto Earthquake and the initiative is now in its third year.

Under TASAKI Online Charity Project “MAGOKORO JAPAN 2018 for KUMAMOTO”, TASAKI will launch the “MAGOKORO JAPAN 2018 for KUMAMOTO Bracelet” (¥18,000 tax excluded) in the TASAKI Online Shop (<http://tasaki-shop.jp>) from Saturday, April 14th.

The dainty bracelet is a pale pink SAKURAGOLD™ charm inspired by cherry blossoms. It features the gentle healing beauty of Freshwater pearls in a design with two hearts nestled together to become one, expressing a deep love and bond. Cherry blossoms appear to come into bloom to offer gentle protection for people, and they express TASAKI's sympathies to the earthquake-hit areas.
